Dear Mr Curtis,


In response to your recent letter about the above application, our comments are as follows:

There is no objection to the proposed BT Street Hub Unit as such, though we always prefer those which provide some additional public benefit, such as a built-in defibrillator.

Our specific concern is that the existing BT InLink unit is set too close to the kerbline, so that it obstructs the view of approaching buses from within the nearby bus shelter. This makes it difficult to see the route numbers, which has become more critical in recent times now that more routes terminate in Brixton Town Centre, instead of continuing into Central London.

It may be sufficient to improve the view for waiting bus passengers if the proposed new unit could be set back another 600mm from the present kerbline.
